The following CIRVIS report was received by London FIC at 1720z. A UFO sighting was reported. The occurrence was last night just after midnight at 1220am local. The object was circular in size, "50 times bigger than an aircraft" and glowed a bright orange colour. The position seemed to be over CHEMONG Lake, near the Town of Bridgenorth, approx 22 min drive north of Peterborough. The object was seen hovering quite quickly back and forth just above the tree line before making a fast departure and disappearing.
