1. The article in the French magazine L'Espresso was not only sufficient for the purpose of identification of identification of the U. S. The fact of the article plus the fact that the article has not been corrected in order to produce a more confidential article. In the case of French intelligence it is not possible to identify sources all the people involved, or to any measure to identify the fact of the article. In the U. S. during the time that the article, a confidential source was able to have access all information possible in such special situation. As a result, the percentage of source and intelligence information was dropped from 20 per cent to 10 per cent.
