



REPORT

I, Polykhaev Valeryi Alekseevich, was coming back home from my work on the 4th of October 1982, at 19.30 and observed a strange unknown phenomenon in the atmosphere at the altitude of about 5-6 km. above the village of Usovo.

After a bus stopped at the cross of roads to Usovo, in the clear space above the road at the altitude of 5-6 km. I saw two brightly shining objects resembling very much a New Year's tree garland in its shape. They were shining with bright-golden light and those lights were twinkling. There were 6-8 brightly shining spots making a circle in every object. The distance between objects was about 2-3 km. Then a shining small ball separated from the left object and moved to the right one. Its size was as the size of small lights. On approaching the right object the ball lost its light. After that the left object moved in the direction of the village of Ozeryany and disappeared, and the right object began to move in our direction. It was moving slowly during 15 sec. and then stopped. While moving the object changed its shape, the twinkling lights reformed from an ellipsis to a straight line. I observed this phenomenon during 5 or 7 minutes then got in the bus and went. The shining object was seen between the tops of trees. On having passed about three kilometers I saw a shining object again in the spare place between trees on the right, but it was higher than those seen before, its lights formed an ellipsis. Then the lights reformed in a line (so the objects changed the angle of the inclination) and went out slowly as if melted away.

On approaching a railway crossing before the station of Topylinja, in the evening sky a brightly shining object resembling a stretched down ellipsis appeared. Its lights were twinkling and changing colours, they were bright-golden. It was at the altitude of 5 km. on the right

of the road above Usovo.

I saw the phenomenon again on the 4 th of October of 1982 at 20.00 near the railway crossing between the station of Topyilnja and v.Zhovtnevo, I was there with my wife, two children and friends in my car. We drove up to the crossing and left the car and observed the sky. We were about 100 m. from the crossing nearer to Topyilnya. Two or three minutes had passed when we saw on the left of the road approximately at the altitude of 5-7 km. a bright light flashed and went out, then it flashed again and after that 6-8 bright-golden lights flashed around it in the shape of an ellipsis. A small brightly shining ball separated from them and flew to the earth and on approaching it went out. In 3-4 minutes myriads of lights went out. In 10 minutes the phenomenon repeated, after two flashes bright golden lights apperaed. In 2-3 minutes the shining object began to move quickly in our side, with a high speed and rising in size. Then the object suddenly stopped. The distance to it was about 1-2 km. Our children were scared that the object fell down on us. After it stopped the light went out slowly as if melted away. In ten minutes another garland "flourished" at a large distance and went out again.

We got in the car and went home.

The shining objects were not seen longer.

EXPLANATION

I, captain Kovalenko A.V., my wife and children and the family of Captain Polykhaev was in the region of the village of Topyilnja from 20.15 to 21.10 and observed an unknown flying object:

-the first one was in the shape of a triangle like

in the drawing:

the upper part was bright-golden with reddish
the lower part was bright-golden

-the second object observed between v.Ozeryany and
the railway station was in the of an ellipsis
the lights of it were dispnsed as shown in the
drawing:

all lights shone with bright-golden

The light was seen for 20 minutes or more, and the two
lower flew down and went out.

Those lights appeared in different places but in one and
the same plane. Only the distance to the object changed
They moved in various directions with a high speed.

The nearest distance the object was from us was about 1,5
km. at the altitude up to 1000 m. According to the position of
lights the object was of an elliptical shape. It is
difficult to describe the object more details, because it
was already dark.

No sound accompanied the movements of the object.

MV (8/2) 32157

I, lieutenant-colonel, Balanov N.A. was coming back home
from my work on the 4th of October 1982 and together with
other passengers of the bus observed luminescence in the sky
unknown to me from 19.20 to 19.40. It was in the shape of
many twinkling stars from pale-yellow to dark-cherry in
colour. Five constellations were seen distinctly. Meanwhile

some of them went out and then appeared again as separate sources of lights of different intensity. They were situated as it shown in the drawing below!

First the luminescence was seen while we moved along the road to the village Perebrody. In order to watch it more precisely we stopped the bus at the crossing of roads Perebrody-Usovo-N.Belokorovichi. The luminescence was seen in a clear space between trees above v.Usovo. The azimuth and the altitude where the luminescence was seen can be estimated from the observing place at the crossing. The second observation of the luminescence took place from the road near the lake Korma. This luminescence was also above v.Usovo. Four bright stars also twinkling were observed at the time. Our first idea was that the luminescence was a reflection of the sun light from a helicopter or a birds' flock, but we began to hesitate that it was the sun's light reflection when the sun set.

When our bus stopped at the turn to v. Zhovtnevo, we got out of the bus and saw bright luminescence of spots changing their colour approximately above v. Usovo. The spots were constantly changing their shape and it seemed that they were moving. When the bus moved we took our seats at the back of the bus and observed the phenomenon with captain Yankov for about ten minutes, then it went out, it was going out slowly as if one after another. And ten minutes later another luminescence appeared, but at some distance from the first. It was larger and had the shape of a circle inclined to the earth. This twinkling light was seen until we reached v. Topilni, and there I saw it last time.

I, lieutenant-colonel Pover V.P., was coming back home from my work by bus 54-32 LI on the 4th of October at about 19.30, it was the part of the road Ignatpol-Usovo, I saw shining lights of the golden colour in the sky, there were 4 or 5 of them.

When the bus stopped the lights didn't move. And while the bus was moving the lights seemed to move together with it.

EXPLANATION

I, major Lipezki V.G., explain by this list that I was coming back home from my work with Captain Ryabinin by my car ZAZ-968M. Driving along the road Perebrody-Usovo I paid attention to the luminescence of some object straight in front of me somewhere above Usovo. The luminescence came from a group of shining spots forming 5 groups. The lights were disposed on the area approximately equal to the area of the setting sun. It was situated at the altitude about 30 m. above the edge of a distant forest. the colour of the lights was from pale-yellow to red. It was 19.10-19.15.

When we stopped at the crossing Usovo-Belokorovichi the lights remained where they were. We stayed at the crossing for about 3 minutes.

We went further, the steering-wheel began to tremble in Captain's hands and the front wheels of the car began to tremble either as if the road was very uneven. Captain Ryabinin stopped the car, checked the steering wheel and front wheels, they were in order. I suggested that I tried to drive the car as I was more experienced driver. The situation repeated after 100 m. though the road wasn't rough. After another 50 m. the process stopped and we reached Belokorovichy normally.

REPORT

I, senior-lieutenant Kobulyansky Vitali Alexandrovich, vice-commander of battery 4 of MU 32156 can inform about the following: On the 4th of October 1982 I left Zhitomir for Korosten at 19.30 by my car Zhiguli. Then on the straight part of the road I saw a bright double spot at an angle of 10 degrees to the horizon, it was twinkling.

My first impression was that they were head lights of the air-plane taking off. My passenger Major Drobakhin supposed that they were signal lights of a retranslator in Chernyakhov. But when we had passed the tower of the retranslator, we saw the lights again approximately in the north and a bit higher above the horizon. Now two groups of lights were seen, they were twinkling irregularly, they were of the reddish colour.

On approaching Korosten we saw that they were forming a "kite", the altitude changed to about 20 degrees above the horizon, left to Korosten.

then we lost the sight of the lights and until we came to Belokorovichi I didn't see them. I noticed them again in the north-western direction above the horizon at about 21.00. The lights were not seen in the town, maybe because of trees. While we were going hindrances arose in our radio in LW and MW as we were coming under high-voltage lines, but there were no high-voltage lines there. EXPLANATION

I, senior assistant of communication service commander of MU 52035 dealing with AC and Computer Systems, Katzman M. Davidovich is reporting by this that on the 4th of October 1982 at 21.37 I observed spontaneous illumination of all displays: BR, P, Sh, DR, GP, SR, PR, CZ, BT, NBT, GP, message, GB message, PP, PS, OR, PNS, Z, PZS, PZNS, figure indicators as in the regime "light marks" at first push on the information board.

On the tape of ARI the information was fixed spontaneously!

- four spaces;
- control code combination at 21.38;
- ZP with chain 1 "message GP" at 21.38

Testing of apparatus and measurement of parameters according to technical map 1-30 showed no defects. The apparatus was functioning normally.

I suppose that this effect can take place as a result of the influence of a powerful impulse on the apparatus's power system, especially on block BP-263(U-10) then on VTG-127 (U5,U3,U2) and then on blocks U14,U12 and U11, bearing the main load in processing data in the apparatus.

No abnormal effects were observed in other communication means. No abnormal effects in ACS chains 5-1 and 4-1 were observed either.

No such cases had been observed before. I consider it necessary to mention that experience showed that apparatus 15394B were weak in power system.

In July of this year during a thunder storm 10 amp.fuse was blown in the power system of apparatus 15394B passing all electric assemblies in order.
